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

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed including the following. Read all instructions.
- 2. To protect against risk of electrical shock, do not put the main body (motor) in water or any other liquid.
- 3. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- 4. Unplug from outlet when not in use, before assembling or taking off parts and before cleaning.
- 5. Avoid contact with moving parts.
- 6. Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug of after the appliance malfunctions, or is dropped or damaged in any manner.
- Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair or electrical or mechanical adjustment.
- 7. The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock or injury.
- 8. Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter.
- Always make sure hopper is securely fastened in place before motor is turned on.
 Do not unfasten hopper while juicer is in operation.
- 10. Be sure to turn switch to off position after each use of your juicer.Make sure the motor stops completely before disassembling.

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IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- 11. Do not put your fingers or other objects into the juicer while it is in operation.

 If food becomes lodged in opening, use food plunger or another piece of fruit or vegetable to push it down. When this method is not possible, turn the motor off and disassemble juicer to remove the remaining food.
- 12. Do not use outdoors.
- 13. Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner or in a hearted over.
- 14. Do not use appliance for other than intended use.





STRAINER*



The bigger holes of the strainer produce thicker juice with tender and soft fruits such as strawberries, kiwis and tomatoes. Use for more pulpy juice.



The holes of the strainer are small. Use for making pure juice with hard fruits, beans or fibrous vegetables. Use to extract clearer juice.

IF AUGER ROTATION STOPS RUNNING DURING NORMAL OPERATION, PRESS [RE-VERSE/REV] BUTTON AND HOLD FOR 2~3 SECONDS. AFTER REVERSE OPERATION HAS COME TO A COMPLETE STOP, PRESS [ON] BUTTON AGAIN. If such stoppage contin-

ues, parts may be damaged and performance may be deteriorated due to overheating of the motor. If problem continues, immediately stop the appliance and contact the local Customer Care Center.



DURING THE OPERATION, DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MOVE THE BASE OR DISASSEMBLE THE CHAMBER SET DURING OPERATION.

It may cause injury or failure. Always switch off first and unplug the power cord before moving or disassembling the appliance.

WARNINGS AND CAUTIONS



WHEN USING THE APPLIANCE, BE CAREFUL TO KEEP LOOSE ITEMS SUCH AS NECKTIE, LONG NECKLACE, SCARF, ETC. AWAY FROM THE HOPPER CHUTE.

It may cause injury, failure or breakage.



PLACE THE APPLIANCE ON A FLAT AND STABLE SURFACE.

It may cause injury or failure.



DO NOT OPERATE THE APPLIANCE FOR MORE THAN 30 MINUTES AT A TIME.

It may cause a motor failure due to overheating.

Cool it down sufficiently for about 5 minutes before operating it again.



WHEN PLACING INGREDIENTS INTO THE HOPPER CHUTE, ONLY USE THE PUSHER PROVIDED.

It may cause injury or failure.



DO NOT APPLY SEVERE SHOCK TO THE APPLIANCE OR DROP IT.

It may cause electric shock, fire or damage.



IF THE APPLIANCE GIVES OFF AN UNPLEASANT SMELL, PRODUCES SMOKE OR HEATS EXCESSIVELY, STOP USING IMMEDIATELY AND CONTACT THE LOCAL CUSTOMER CARE CENTER.

When using a new appliance, it may initially give off a smell. The smell will disappear naturally over time.



ALWAYS UNPLUG THE APPLIANCE AFTER USE. WHEN UNPLUGGING THE POWER CORD. MAKE SURE TO HOLD THE HEAD OF THE POWER CORD.

Pulling on the wire to unplug may cause electric shock or fire.



DO NOT WASH AT HIGH TEMPERATURES OF 80°C(176°F) OR HIGHER.

DO NOT PLACE THE APPLIANCE IN A DISHWASHER. A DRYER OR A MICROWAVE.




THE APPLIANCE WEIGHS ABOUT 6.35KG (14LB).
WHEN MOVING THE APPLIANCE, ALWAYS SECURELY HOLD BY THE GRIP ON THE BOTTOM OF THE BASE WITH BOTH HANDS.

Do not hold the appliance by the chamber or the edge of the base. The base may slip and drop, causing injury or failure.


SLOW JUICER ASSEMBLY

HOW TO USE THE APPLIANCE



Motor does not stop immediately upon pressing [Reverse/REV]. For safety reasons and to preserve the performance level of the appliance, the motor will slowly come to a complete stop.


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JUICE CAP AND EXTRACTION SEAL

JUICE CAP

This is the juice outlet cap on the chamber.

Close the juice cap to fill up the chamber with juice from various ingredients.




Close juice cap and press [ON] button to start.

When juice starts filling up the chamber, you can mix banana, nuts, boiled sweet potato, etc. and liquids such as milk as well as vegetables and fruits for a unique smoothie.


Open the juice cap to pour out as much juice as you need and close it to save the juice for another serving without any drops or mess on the counter.

EXTRACTION SEAL

This is the pulp stopper made of silicone located at the bottom of the chamber. Always close the extraction seal before every use as shown below. For cleaning, open the extraction seal and wash out the trapped food particles. (Page 16)



WHEN THE AUGER IS STOPPED DURING OPERATION (REVERSE/REV BUTTON)



Click the [Reverse/REV] button on the operating switch and stop the appliance.

Hold down the [Reverse/REV] on the operating switch for $3{\sim}5$ seconds and release it. Repeat this process $2{\sim}3$ times.

Reverse button pushes the ingredients back up. Reverse only works while the button held down. The Reverse rotation of the auger stops once the button is released.

After the rotation stops completely, press [ON] button to operate.

Before changing the rotation direction of the auger, make sure that auger has come to a complete stop.

NOTE

If the auger does not work even after following the directions above, unplug the power cord form the electrical outlet, disassemble and clean the chamber set before attempting again.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS FOR USE

- · Fruits with pits and hard seeds such as nectarines, peaches, mangos, apricots, plums and cherries must be pitted before juicing.
- · Cut fibrous ingredients (water parsleys, etc) into small sizes about 3~4cm(1.5inch) before placing into the hopper chute.
- · Drink the fruit juice or green vegetable juice immediately after extraction.

The juice will lose taste and nutritional value longer it is exposed to air.

- \cdot Do not use the appliance for grinding dry ingredients such as grains, coffee beans, etc.
- This may damage the parts or cause failure of the appliance.
- · Do not re-squeeze leftovers expelled through the pulp outlet.
- · Do not operate the appliance when the chamber is empty.



DO NOT USE CONTINUOUSLY FOR MORE THAN 30 MINUTES.

It may cause a failure due to overheating of the motor.

When using continuously, stop and cool it down for about 5 minutes after each use.



NEVER INSERT FINGER, FORK OR SPOON, ETC. INTO THE JUICER OUTLET DURING OPERATION.

Inserting foreign objects into the juice outlet during operation may cause the spinning bush to become stuck and damage the parts



USE ONLY THE PUSHER TO PRESS DOWN THE INGREDIENTS.

Any other objects may damage the parts and cause injury or failure of equipment.



DO NOT PLACE GRAINS, FRUIT WITH HARD SEED OR NUTS WITH HARD SHELL SUCH AS WALNUTS INTO THE JUICER.

It may damage the chamber, auger, squeezing strainer, etc.

Fruits with pits, hard seeds such as nectarines, peaches, mangos, apricots, plums and cherries must be pitted before juicing.



DO NOT OPERATE SWITCHES WITH WET HANDS.

It may cause electric shock or fire.

Do not put foreign objects on or near the switch.



DO NOT USE FOR MEAT OR SEAFOOD.

It may cause abnormal performances or a failure.



DO NOT USE FOR FRUIT PRESERVED IN SUGAR, HONEY, ALCOHOL, ETC. (GRAPES, APRICOT, BERRES, ETC.)

It may cause the hopper to become stuck and difficult to open.




Frozen fruit or withered ingredients that have been stored in the refrigerator for a long time may produce less juice or may be difficult to juice.



DISASSEMBLING, CLEANING AND CARE




- 1. Ensure the motor has stopped completely and unplug the power cord.
 - When unplugging the power cord, hold the head part of the power cord and unplug it. Do not touch the power cord with wet hands.
- 2. Hold the juice outlet and the hopper with both hands and lift them up from the base.
- 3. Disassemble parts as below:
 - 1) Unlock the chamber by rotating it counterclockwise.
 - 2) Remove the auger.
 - 3) Remove the strainer.
 - 4) Remove the spinning brush.
- 4. Rinse each part with the cleaning brush. Brush the inside and outside of each part thoroughly under running water.
 - Never use scouring pads, abrasive cleaning agents, harsh detergents or sharp cleaning tools. Do not wash the parts in the dishwasher or a dish dryer.
- 5. Wipe the base with a soft, damp cloth and dry thoroughly.
 - Do not immerse the base unit in water or any other liquid or rinse it under running water.
- 6. After cleaning, allow the parts to air-dry completely and store it in a clean and safe place.
 - Always wash the chamber set immediately after use. Without prompt cleaning, the pulp residue may dry and crust on the parts, making it difficult to disassemble or clean at a later time. Improper cleaning may also cause decreased performance of the appliance.

DISASSEMBLING AND CLEANING THE CHAMBER

1 Remove the juice cap seal and the chamber seal.

Open juice cap first. Hold the chamber and juice cap with one hand and peel off the juice cap seal with the other hand. Remove the chamber seal by pinching and twisting it off with fingers.




Wash the chamber and the seals with cleaning brush under the running water.

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
STERILIZATION AND EASY CLEANING SYSTEM

STERILIZATION




► Sterilize all washable parts by immersing in a dilute solution of baking soda (about 1~2 teaspoon in 1 quart of water) for 30 minutes.

EASY CLEANING SYSTEM



It is not necessary to disassemble and wash the chamber every time between different recipes. However, always disassemble and wash the chamber set after the last juicing.

DISASSEMBLING AND CLEANING THE SPINNING BRUSH



Remove the spinning brush from strainer.


Detach the silicone brush from the spinning brush.

As shown in the figure, hold the outer part of silicone brush and pull it out gently in the direction of the arrow. Silicone brush may be torn or damaged if it is pulled apart forcefully.

With the cleaning brush, wash inside and outside of spinning brush under running water.

Clean the silicone brush in the same way under running water.

ASSEMBLING THE SPINNING BRUSH




Check the groove of the spinning brush and the direction of silicone brush.

There are grooves to insert silicone brush in the spinning brush.

Silicone brush has inner wing 1 and outer wing

As shown in the figure on left, position the silicone brush so the 'inner wing' faces the spinning brush.



Insert the silicone brush into the spinning brush.


- ► Hold the wing so the longer part of inner wing face upward (see Step above).
- ► Hold the outer wing ② of silicone brush with your thumb and index finger and insert the inner wing into the groove of spinning brush.

Pull the inner wing tightly into the spinning brush.

- Push the silicone brush in from the outside and pull the inner wing into the spinning brush with the other hand. (See figure)
- Pull the silicone brush tightly into the groove on the spinning brush. The unit may be damaged if it is operated without being properly and fully assembled.
- Make sure the silicone brush is placed firmly into the groove by holding the top and bottom part of the outer wing and pulling it up and down in opposite directions.


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ASSEMBLING THE CHAMBER SEAL



Hold the chamber seal by pinching it between the thumb and index finger.

As shown to the left in the dotted circle, let the protruding part on the chamber seal face upward when you hold it by pinching it between the thumb and index finger.




Insert the chamber seal into the chamber hole.

Insert the bottom of the chamber seal into the chamber hole and press it down fully. Do not insert the entire chamber seal. The upper part of the chamber seal must stay above the chamber hole.

Turn over the chamber and settle the chamber seal into place.

If the chamber seal at the bottom of the chamber is not fully installed, set it into place properly with the rotating pick on the end of the cleaning brush.

ASSEMBLING THE JUICE CAP SEAL



Hold juice cap seal as shown on the

As shown on the left in the dotted circle, the opening on the seal must be visible when you hold the seal.

Open the juice cap and fit the juice cap seal on to the inner disk.

▶ Be careful not to drop the chamber.

Arrange the seal for a complete fit.

If the seal is not placed correctly, it may cause juice leakage.



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TROUBLESHOOTING

Please check the details below before contacting Technical Support for repair or service.

If you need additional information, please contact the local Customer Care Center or visit www.hurom.com.

When applying for after-sales service, please have the manufacturer's serial number or bar code available.

THE APPLIANCE DOES NOT WORK.

Make sure the power cord is properly plugged in.

Check if the hopper is assembled properly. If the hopper has not been locked into place, the appliance will not operate for safety reasons.

Check if the appliance has been assembled according to the directions given in the manual.

Refer to the assembling instructions in the manual or consult with a local Customer Care Center for additional assistance.

THE HOPPER DOES NOT OPEN.

Is there lot of pulp left inside the chamber? Press [ON] button to expel excess pulp.

Have you placed any foreign substances or solid objects such as hard seeds in the juicer?

Press the [Reverse/REV] button to bring the foreign objects back up toward the hopper chute.

DO NOT attempt to open the hopper by force. If the issue is not resolved after following the above process, contact the local Customer Care Center.

THE APPLIANCE STOPS DURING NORMAL OPERATION.

Have you put in heavy loads or large pieces of ingredients into the appliance?

Read page 12 of the manual and follow the guideline for using [Reverse/REV] button.

If the issue is not resolved after following the above process, contact the local Customer Care Center.

THERE ARE FINE LINES OR SCRATCH MARKS ON THE PRODUCT.

These are molding marks resulting from the normal manufacturing process. This is a normal product and there is no problem for use.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN FINE STRAINER AND COARSE STRAINER?

Use the fine strainer with smaller holes for clearer, less pulpy juice.

Use the coarse strainer with bigger holes for thicker, more pulpy juice.

Refer to page 3 of the manual for selection of suitable ingredients for each strainer.

JUICE LEAKS OVER THE BASE.

Is extraction seal inserted properly?

Juice could leak out when the extraction seal is loose or has not been inserted properly. Push the extraction seal all the way for a tight seal.

Juice is still leaking even with the extraction seal inserted correctly.

Overloading may be the problem. If the chamber is overloaded with ingredients, the extraction seal may be pushed out of position, allowing the juice to leak out through the gap. Always juice small, manageable amount of ingredients at a time and avoid processing heavy loads.

THE CHAMBER SHAKES DURING OPERATION.

Slight shaking may be caused by the motor.

Depending on the texture of the ingredient, there may be slight to more pronounced shaking of the appliance.

There is some level of shaking when the auger is rotating. This is a normal occurrence and not a malfunction.

Hard ingredients (e.g. carrot, potato, radish, beet, etc.) may cause more shaking than soft ingredients.
